C C Bexley Open 10 Time Trial

We are promoting this event on 3rd June, with the first rider away at 15:00. Race HQ is our usual spot at the Lower Stoke Village Hall.

The course is Q10/24 Isle of Grain.

Besides solos on TT bikes, there will be a separate event for solo road bikes too.

Enter online via the CTT website, entry fee is £12.00. Entries need to be submitted by midnight on 26th May.

This event is also the C C Bexley 10 Mile TT Championship, so make sure you get your entry in.
